PBDC Federal Group: INVITED TO

CUTTING-EDGE R&D AIRFORCE CONFERENCE

PBDC Federal Group continues to attract world class talent. This includes Potawatomi Training General Manager Dawn Calandra, who formerly was the program manager for the Royal Saudi Air Force **English Language** Training (ELT) school at Sheppard Air Force

Base (SPS) in Texas.



Calandra now oversees the contract that supports the Innovation Center (formerly the Sparks Team) at SPS. SPS is an international operation training site that trains pilots from around the world, including active NATO personnel. Our team at the 80th supports pilot flight training on the T38 and T6 aircraft.

Last year, the Innovation Center created the Aircraft Tractile Training Console (ATTC) to facilitate immersive training for new pilots by creating a training experience that more accurately approximates a real flying experience. Developed by Federal Group programmers (with the help of a 3D printer), the ATTC improves muscle memory and reaction time by including flight sticks and throttles that pilots may have to navigate around, as well as a 360-degree view, which similar training options lack.

The ATTC is estimated to significantly decrease in-air pilot training time, which in turn reduces the fuel expenses for and wear-and-tear on field aircrafts. The



Innovation Center has found that new pilots with ATTC access have increased their repetitive training and real-time feedback loop by 25%.

In light of the ATTC, AFWERX, an R&D project of the U.S. Air Force, invited the Federal Group's Innovation Center to

share its solution at San Antonio. AFWERX brings academic and industry teams to apply their latest innovations to government challenges. It is also a chance for R&D professionals to talk to Air Force personnel to understand their challenges and what solutions they may need.

AFWERK coincides with FORCECON, a major gaming and technology conference where PBDC employees can learn the latest in AI and cybertechnologies specifically for military purposes. The Federal Group was represented at both FORCECON and AFWERK conferences in San Antonio May 28 – 29. The team successfully demonstrated the ATTC and heard interest from several parties who agreed that the ATTC can increase pilot training efficiency.



PBDC: FORMS NEW BUSINESS UNIT TO **DEVELOP ELECTRIC VEHICLE OFFERINGS**

integrators. This approach aligns well with other EV efforts the **Forest County** Potawatomi Community has already established."

PBDC has observed a growing need for electric vehicle technologies across its

customers and subsidiaries and has positioned the new Business Unit to develop innovative solutions to meet this need. "We expect all to provide significant synergies pertaining to efforts in the EV market."


